Pharmacy Technicians

Pharmacy technicians perform a variety of tasks associated with dispensing medicinal products under the guidance of a pharmacist or other health professional. Tasks include:

- preparing medications and other pharmaceutical compounds under the guidance of pharmacists
- dispensing medicines and drugs to clients and giving written and oral instructions on their use, as prescribed by medical doctors, veterinarians or other authorised workers
- receiving prescriptions or refill requests from health professionals and verifying that information is complete and accurate maintaining proper storage and security conditions for drugs
