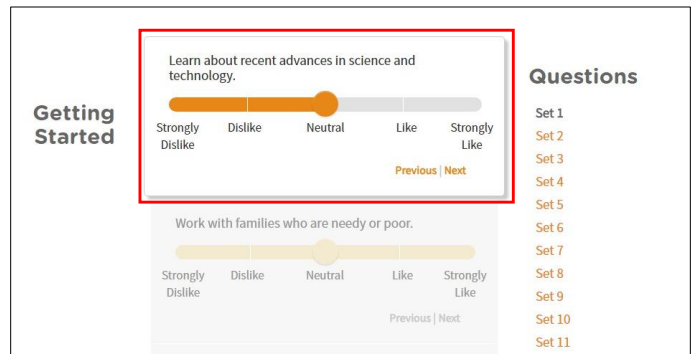
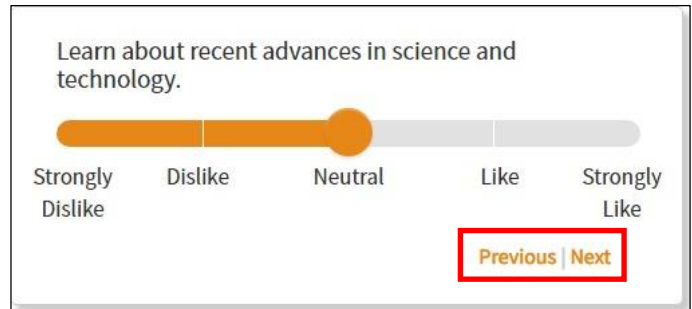

<p>2.</p>	<p>The <b>Career Interests</b> tool consists of 11 sets of <b>Questions</b> with each set having 6 statements.</p> <p>Take the Tool in Classic or Drag and Drop style.</p> <p>Indicate your preference of <b>Strongly Dislike</b> to <b>Strongly Like</b> via two ways:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Classic</b> – Click on the scale</li> <li>• <b>Drag and Drop</b> – Click and drag the icon</li> </ul>	

3. Click **Next** to lead you to the next statement. Click **Previous** to go back to previous question.

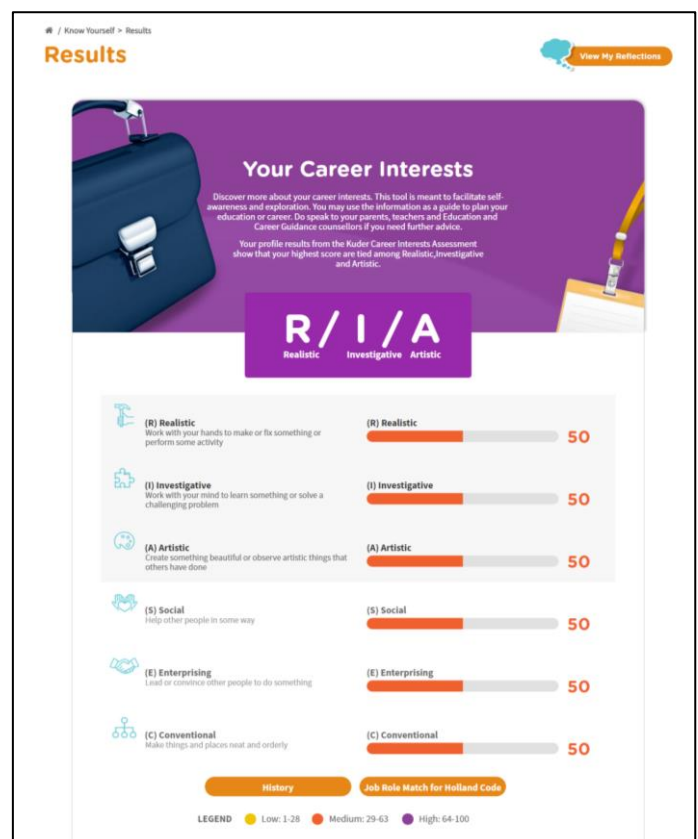





4. After you have completed the tool, the **Results** are displayed, including your Holland Personality types.

- Expressed as a three-letter Holland Code, such as RCE, SEA, IER, etc.
- The **first letter** describes your highest Holland Code and interests
- The **second and third letters** describe interests and personality characteristics in descending order from the highest interest area to the lowest interest area

**Job Role Description**

The Urban Forester plans where to plant trees in the cities. He/she selects trees that will withstand hard city environments. He/she works with land owners and government officials. He/she inspects trees to determine their health. He/she prunes the trees to ensure that they continue to grow properly. He/she also removes tree branches that are dead or dying.

**Tasks**

- Choose and prepare sites for new trees, with controlled burning, bulldozers, or herbicides to clear weed and dirt.
- Conduct public educational programmes on forest care and conservation.
- Explore ways of cutting and removing wood with the least waste and damage to the environment.
- Form ways for measuring and spotting trees.
- Perform inspections of forests or forest nurseries.
- Plan cutting programmes, take care of sale of wood from harvested areas, and help companies to meet production goals.
